In the midst of this pandemic, we at AAVH are taking any and all precautions to keep your pets, you and your loved ones, as well as our clinic staff safe. Here are some newer updates from us that we would like to share.

In addition to doubling down on our disinfecting after rooms, we will offer “curb-side” service for you and your pet. Given school closings if you or your young ones do not wish to increase your exposure by entering the facility one of our staff will collect your pet from the vehicle while you wait.

Wellness visits for vaccinations are critical especially for new puppies as we do not want to have any companion animal outbreaks of preventable diseases. As the weather starts to improve and we move forward into spring the number of canine parvovirus and feline infectious upper respiratory cases increases between the months of March and May. Flea and tick pests are soon to return from their semi-dormant state.

If you or anyone in your household is sick or has a fever we do for the safety of our staff and the community to reschedule or remain at home unless a critical emergency arises with your pet. We will always make accommodations for you and your pets in the event of an emergency.

Our cleanliness protocol: in addition to using a concentrated disinfectant that we have confirmed with the company is an effective virucidal agent against COVID-19. After each client leaves the facility our staff is wiping down the front desk countertop and wiping down the interior and exterior door handles.
